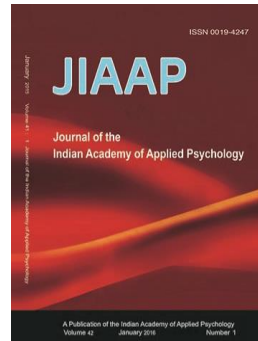

Jaipur founded by Maharaja Jai Singh-II (1693-1743), famous world over as the "Pink City" is 260 km from Delhi and is a major destination in the popular Golden Triangle of Delhi-Agra-Jaipur. Title: Times New Roman, Size 16 pts.

Author(s): Times New Roman, Size 14 pts.

Affiliation: Times New Roman, Size 12 pts.

Abstract: Times New Roman, Size 12 pts., single spacing

The abstract should briefly include the purpose of study, material and method, results and conclusions. At the bottom of the page, please indicate the category (thrust area/ subtheme) and the preference for presentation (oral/ poster). The name of the presenting author should be underlined and his/her email address should be mentioned.

Full Paper Submission

Title: Times New Roman, size 18, bold

Authors: Times New Roman, size 12pts. in the order Last name & First Name

Text: Times New Roman, size 12pts. It should comprise Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussions & References (According to APA format)

Tables and Graphs: Should be made according to the APA format

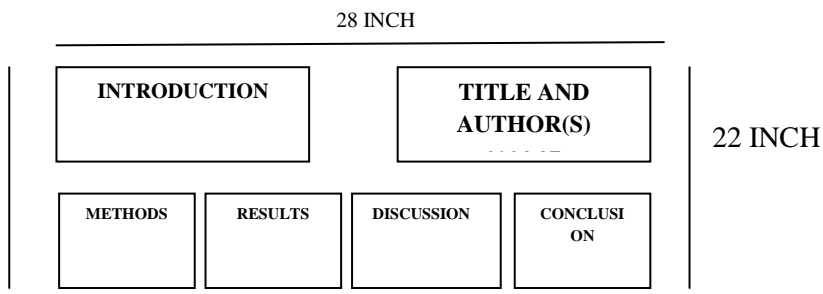
ORAL/ POSTER PRESENTATION

Oral Presentation
