Faster growth has obvious implications for the pace and nature of urbanization. Urbanization is an integral part of the process of economic growth. As in most countries, India's towns and cities make a major contribution to the country's economy.

The pace and growth of urbanization in India poses enormous challenges to urban governance. Urban Governance is derived from the concept of governance in relation to urban areas to be reflective of how the various constituents of public service delivery are organized to increase the welfare of citizens (both present and future). There are many issues associated with the governance of urban areas like lack of funds and planning, prolonged public service delivery, waste management, unemployment, unaffordable housing, and service provisions as well as the emergence of newer concerns around climate change, growing insecurity and migration which needs closer understanding.

While urban regions across the world present some of the most complex challenges with regard to environmental, economic and social sustainability, they also offer some of the greatest opportunities. The government has taken many initiatives like Smart City Mission, AMRUT (Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation), Housing for all by 2022 and Swach Bharat Abhiyan.

The present conference is an endeavor to focus on the challenges of urban governance and urban development for the ongoing and future governance. The challenges are manifold and thus urban governance needs to be looked at from fresh perspective and be given serious consideration to avoid future pandemonium in urban areas. Thus, this conference will provide a platform to scholars, teachers, researchers, and other stakeholders to understand and deliberate on the issues of urban governance and understand the initiatives taken to make a robust governance model for urban areas. The conference aims to facilitate discussion on these aspects and envision future research imperatives.
