(E) Major Achievements as Head, Department of Philosophy, University of Rajasthan:

- (1) **Academic Events of Eminence:** Organizing of four International and four National Seminars. In one of the International Seminars, Prof. Ernest Sosa, Father of Virtue Epistemology participated as the keynote speaker.
- (2) **Lecture Series:** Organizing of three one-week long lecture series by eminent scholars.
- (3) **Departmental Journal:** Started Peer-reviewing and simultaneous-publication via online mode of the departmental journal, *Journal of Foundational Research*. The Editorial Board has been redrawn keeping in mind highest international standards, the board as of now has three international members while ten other Indian scholars of global repute are on the board.

The Journal has recently been included in UGC-CARE List.

- (4) **Publications:** Publication of four issues of departmental journal and four other monographs from the department.
- (5) **Chain of Seminars for students:** Started Weekly Seminar series for research scholars and PG Students.
- (6) **Recognition to the department by Eminent Bodies:** Identification of the department as a **Study-Centre of ICPR, MHRD, New Delhi.**
- (7) **Centre for Philosophical Counselling:** Opening up of a centre with a vision to conduct theoretical research in Philosophical Counselling and to offer counselling services is under-process.
- (8) **Designing and Updating of Course Curricula:** A fresh course on Masters in Yoga Philosophy has been designed and in-process to be passed by Academic Council. Further, contents of core papers of Indian Philosophy, Buddhism, Philosophy of Language, Post Modernism and Hermeneutics have been updated.

(F) Future academic and corporate plans:

- 1. Assessment of the Philosophical Contributions of Philosophers from the Department:** Multiple scholars/philosophers of International repute worked and philosophized at Department of Philosophy, University of Rajasthan. Prof. P. T. Raju, Prof. Dayakrishna, Prof. Ramchandra Gandhi, Prof. Biswambhar Pahi philosophized not only upon the history of Indian philosophy but also on fresh questions of independent importance. At present, I am making an attempt to survey some of the works of Raju, Dayakrishna and Pahi and understand the common lines of intersection in these thinkers.
- 2. Ethnographical Method in Philosophy and Philosophy as Autobiography:** One of the primary reasons behind the question-marks upon relevance of philosophy in India is because the contemporary philosophers in India deal with problems which are uncontemporary. Thus, to my mind one of the ways to make philosophy in India relevant and contemporary is, by following ethnographical method. By ethnographical method in philosophy, I mean philosophizing on living issues. This is the only way to make philosophy relevant and contemporary. Gandhi and Ambedkar are instances of thinker dealing with living problems, and this accounts for their popularity and relevance as philosophers. In this research project I am making an attempt to develop ethnographical method in philosophy.
- 3. A textbook for Continental Philosophy in Hindi:** There is absolute dearth of reading material on Continental philosophy in Hindi language. A textbook on Continental philosophy in Hindi has been planned by me and other faculty members of the department. The same shall incorporate representative articles/ excerpts from books of major Continental thinkers so as to provide basic reading material to post-graduate students.

4. A Textbook Based on Primary Sources in Classical Indian Philosophy: One of the primary reasons behind faulty understanding of Indian philosophy lies in the fact that till post-graduate level most of the students study Indian Philosophy exclusively through secondary sources. The proposed textbook shall incorporate representative primary literature from classical systems in Saṁskṛta as well as its Hindi/English translation.

5. Designing of Short-term Certificate and Diploma Courses:

The department is presently working to develop short-term certificate and diploma courses on:

- a. Philosophical Counselling
- b. Logical Reasoning
- c. Professional Ethics
- d. Administrative Ethics
- e. Philosophy and Life skills
- f. Gandhian Philosophy

6. Designing of Fresh Masters Courses: Given the vastness of Indian philosophy and the relevance of Yoga, faculty members of the department are working to design separate courses on M.A in Indian Philosophy and M.A. in Yoga. The draft curriculum on M. A. in Yoga is ready and has been tabled before concerned bodies for further processes.
