Certificate Course in Painting	One Academic Year	10+2 of any recognized Board

Annual Scheme of Examination will be followed.

1. Each theory paper shall be of 3 hrs. duration.

2. The no. of papers, time duration of practical exam and the minimum and maximum marks for each paper has been mentioned in the syllabus

3. There shall be 9 questions in each theory paper out of which the candidate will be required to

attempt 5 questions in all.

4. .A candidate has to secure 40% marks in individual papers (Theory & Practical) Candidate securing 75% and above marks will be awarded Pass with honors. 60% in I Division, and 50% will be required for a pass.

5. A candidate securing less than 40% marks in max. of one paper, shall be allowed to take the exam

in the successive academic year only.

6. Candidate needs to clear all exams in order to be eligible for promotion to the next level of courses. If a candidate fails in any practical she/he has to repeat the year.

7. Internal assessment will constitute 30% of the total marks of each practical & theory paper. Overall assessment shall be on the basis of submissions, Internal Exams & regularity in attendance.

8. A candidate passing the certificate course in Painting shall be eligible to seek admission to the Diploma course.

9. The Certificate shall be awarded by the University.
